Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting

Minutes of the meeting of Hibaldstow Parish Council held at 7.15pm on Thursday 12th December 2013 at the Village Hall, Hibaldstow.

Cllr Brooks opened the meeting.

174. Apologies for absence

Apologies for absence received from Cllrs Broomhall, Talliss & White.

175. Declaration of Interest

176. Minutes of Previous minutes

The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 14th November, 2013 were approved and signed as a true and correct record.

177. Clerk's Report

- a) Clerk has chased up the concerns regarding car parking issues on Church Lane/Dunns Lane. NLC have letter dropped the area asking for comments on parking and received no feedback. A further resident contacted the Clerk today regarding parking concerns in this area – Clerk to pass on this information and ask for a further site visit.
- b) Clerk has written to CI Forbes regarding recent incidents at the Village Hall justifying the need for the current team to stay as is to provide support for the village. Awaiting a response.
- c) Overgrown and fallen trees on Denton Way reported to NLC who stated there were no trees. Clerk to organise a site visit with Cllr Wragg & NLC.
- d) PA/2013/0658 – Clerk withdrew the objection based on conditions being agreed between residents, NLC Officer and the applicant.
- e) Clerk has written to Mr Steward and the War Memorial Committee to inform them that at present there are no requirements for the facility but would review if and when this changed.

178. Chairman's Report

Cllr Brooks attended the official opening of the 2nd phase of the Brigg Heritage Centre followed by the Brigg Town Xmas light switch on.

The crime stats from Humberside Police were circulated prior to the meeting.

The NATs meeting was held last night but due to Cllr Charlton assisting with the flooding at South Ferriby he had not been able to attend.

- b) Ridge Councillors to update the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council.

Cllr England stated that the flooding had been a high priority for NLC and that the Ridge Ward had been relatively unaffected.

NLC are providing all flood victims with £300. All areas had been evacuated quickly and NLC are providing various pieces of equipment to help with the clean up.

332 homes within the area had been affected.

The Pods had been used as an emergency centre seeing 60 people staying overnight there.

The communication between NLC and the Environment Agency was not that good and this will be looked into.

181. Village Hall / Playing Fields

Cllr Wragg provided an update to the Council stating there had been a meeting on 03/12 prior to the Xmas Fair which was well attended.

The Chair of the Committee had resigned.

Clerk to chase up the signage and road issues raised for Gainsthorpe Road and ask if the stats could be provided for the current HGV monitoring when they were available.

Clerk to also report excessive mud on West Street.

The hedge has been infilled, seeing the wind breaker repaired and reinstated.
